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IGA SWIATEK WINS 2026 NATIONAL BANK OPEN PRESENTED BY ROGERS TO CLAIM FIRST TITLE OF SEASON

- *Katerina Siniakova and Shuai Zhang victorious in doubles*
- *Record attendance for WTA year in Toronto*

[TORONTO, ON] August 13, 2026 – Iga Swiatek of Poland won the National Bank Open presented by Rogers (NBO) singles title by defeating Elena Rybakina of Kazakhstan 6-2, 6-3 on Thursday night, while Katerina Siniakova of Czechia and partner Shuai Zhang of China won the doubles title overcoming Sara Errani of Italy and American Nicole Melichar-Martinez 6-3, 6-4 in the final.

The NBO final featured a 13th meeting between No. 2 seed Rybakina and No. 7 seed Swiatek, with their head-to-head record tied at six wins apiece entering the match. It was their second meeting in a final, following Swiatek's victory over Rybakina at the 2024 Qatar Open – also a WTA 1000 event. Tonight's matchup marked the first NBO final between two Top 10 players since 2018, when world No. 1 Simona Halep defeated world No. 3 Sloane Stephens.

"First of all, Elena [Rybakina], congrats for a great tournament – you had tough matches and you're such a great competitor," said Swiatek during her on-court interview. "It's always tough to play against you. We've played many important matches against each other, and I'm sure there's many, many more to come. So, congrats to you, your team, and hopefully we see each other soon in another tournament, hopefully in a final... I'm really happy about this tournament. It means so, so much. These past few months have not been easy. I'm really happy that I've kept focusing on growing, changing my game a little bit, and improving despite the opinions so many people have about me."

En route to the final, Swiatek defeated Sara Bejlek, Viktorija Golubic, Marta Kostyuk, Diana Shnaider and Elina Svitolina, picking up three Top 20 wins along the way. It marks the first time she has recorded three Top 20 victories at a single event since her 2024 Roland Garros title run. With her win over Rybakina, Swiatek now has 12 WTA 1000 titles, 26 Tour-level crowns, and a 26-5 career record in championship matches. It marks her first title of the 2026 season.

"Congratulations to Iga Swiatek on capturing the title, what an excellent tournament she has had," said Karl Hale, Tournament Director, NBO Toronto. "It's been our pleasure to host Iga and all the players who participated in the National Bank Open presented by Rogers. I want to thank our incredible partners, who have contributed in providing a wonderful, elevated experience for all attendees throughout Sobeys Stadium. We set multiple attendance records during the tournament, including record attendance for a WTA event, as we see interest in tennis continue to grow from coast to coast to coast. We plan to build on that momentum as we look forward to 2027."

An attendance record of 215,872 was set for National Bank Open women's event in Toronto. Only nine days into the tournament, attendance stood at 176,652 which is a record after that number of days, the previous record stood at 175,669 set in 2025. Four sessions were sold-out during the tournament, marking the most sold-out sessions for a WTA Tour Toronto event.

SINIAKOVA AND ZHANG CAPTURE DOUBLES TITLE

Siniakova and partner Zhang won the National Bank Open doubles title. The pair defeated Sara Errani of Italy and American Nicole Melichar-Martinez 6-3, 6-4. Siniakova wins her second NBO title, having previously captured the crown in 2019 alongside fellow Czech Barbora Krejčíková. Zhang goes one better than her previous best result in Canada, having finished as runner-up in 2025 alongside Taylor Townsend. Zhang (37) becomes the oldest women's doubles tournament winner since Lisa Raymond (38) in 2011.

"It means a lot. It's a really nice thing to have this trophy, and have so many matches, good matches on our belt. Yeah, it's always fun to play with Shuai also, so much positivity. So, definitely feeling great. I mean, it's amazing," said Siniakova.
